At the Lanificio we've always had very clear that **the most important thing to consider is the health** of our employees and stakeholders. So far, we have managed to conduct our activities on a regular basis while applying all governmental provisions and safeguarding employees: as of today, we are not aware of any of our employees being affected by the contagion. And this is what most matters.

On March 21st the Italian Government decided to tighten the current lockdown, including further activities and industries that have been detailed through a Ministerial Decree. In addition, both regions Piedmont and Lombardy have provided for further restrictive measures to production activities deemed "non-essential". In adherence with the tighter measures adopted, **we are forced to put on hold the activities of the wool mill**, including production and logistics, while remaining available for all other business functions that can be carried out remotely via the home office.

Once the activity can restart, **we will adopt all the necessary measures**, including rotation during the holiday period if necessary, in order to minimise the impact this extraordinary event might have on everybody's field of activity.

The lockdown is currently planned until April 3rd, and we will keep you posted about further developments. All services rendered by our Hong Kong subsidiary (including made to measure) are not affected by the above-mentioned measures.
